(fixed-term employment under the Peruvian Labor Rules for the period of 2 months (minimum) up to 4 months (maximum), for five-teen hours/week, between April and December 2019)

Your main duties includes the development of teaching courses or seminars in Criminology, development of research seminars with professors, students or both of them, preparation of academic publications indexed or refereed in academic Journals selected, development of specialized conferences, and the creation or participation in research projects. In addition, the visiting professors may develop activities related to: a) Meetings with research groups; b) Scientific or methodological advice, and c) Other academic activities coordinated with the Psychology Department such as academic helping to set up the first Master in Criminology in Peru. You will work in cooperation with other Peruvian professors from PUCP (with Master and PhD Degrees in Criminology obtained in Europe) on the same project.

More precisely with the schedule charge, your duties per week will be:

- ✓ Develop Criminology courses or seminars (3 hours/week).
- ✓ Develop research seminars with other professors, students or both (2 hours/week).
- ✓ Develop of specialized conferences (2 hours/week).
- ✓ Creation or participation in research projects (3 hours/week).
- ✓ Preparation of academic publications (manuscripts for papers/articles) indexed or refereed in academic journals selected (2 hours/week).
- ✓ In addition, visiting professors may develop activities related to (3 hours/week):
 - Meetings with research groups
 - Scientific or methodological advice
 - Other academic activities coordinated with the Academic Department of Psychology

1. PhD (in Criminology or Psychology or Sociology or Anthropology or Education or Politic Science or History or Criminal Justice or Law), Master and Bachelor degree in Criminology (mandatory) completed at a domestic/national or foreign University.
2. Affinity/interest with and/or work experience in Latin-America or South-America.
3. Strong experience with teaching and research in Criminology at University Level.
4. Willing to stay 2 until 4 months in Peru at 2019 (the starting date is flexible).
5. Fluency in English, both in written and oral form (fluent in Spanish is a plus).
